

6 New Fields Recognized in Kansas

61 New Fields Established in State This Year

The **Kansas Geological Society's** Nomenclature Committee, in association with the **Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC)** and the **Kansas Geological Survey**, has named 6 new oil and gas fields in Kansas at a recent meeting held in Wichita, Kansas. This brings the total number of new fields recognized this year to 61, or 7 fields less than were reported for the same period a year ago, a gain of nearly 10.3 percent.

There were also 2 new "infield" discoveries recognized, bringing the total number of new oil and gas discoveries of *all types* in 2010 to 80. This is up by 3 new fields, or nearly 3.9 percent, compared to last year. New "Infield wildcat" discoveries are those wells located within established field boundaries but are over one-half mile from known oil production, or over one mile from known gas production in the field. The KGS Nomenclature Committee also extended the boundaries of 21 existing fields, recognized new pay sources in 2 fields and the revival of 2 previously abandoned fields.
